

# Opium State And Society Chinas Narco Economy And The Guomindang 1924 1937

Opium, State, and Society  
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surprisingly little has been written about the complicated relationship between opium and china and its people opium state and society goes a long way toward illuminating this relationship in the republican period when all levels of chinese society from peasants to school teachers merchants warlords and ministers of finance were physically or economically dependent on the drug the centerpiece of this study is an investigation of the symbiotic relationship that evolved between opium and the guomintang s rise to power in the years 1924 1937 despite attempts to find other sources of revenue the guomintang became increasingly addicted to the tax monies derived from the drug trade prior to the war with japan based solidly on a previously untapped reservoir of archival sources from the people s republic and taiwan this work critically analyzes the complex realities of a government policy that vacillated between prohibition and legalization and ultimately sought to curtail the cultivation sale and consumption of opium through a government monopoly

this projected ten volume edition of mao zedong s writings provides abundant documentation in his own words regarding his life and thought it has been compiled from all available chinese sources including the many new texts that appeared in 1993 mao s centenary

a descriptively annotated multidisciplinary cross referenced and extensively indexed guide to 2 395 dissertations that are concerned either in whole or in part with hong kong and with hong kong chinese students and emigres throughout the world

well grounded on abundant japanese language sources which have been underused this book uncovers the league of nations works in east asia in the inter war period by researching the field of social and other technical issues namely the trade in narcotics the trafficking of women and the work in terms of improving health provision and providing economic advice to nationalist china it not only examines their long term impacts on the international relations in the region but also argues that the league s works challenged the existing imperial order of east and southeast asia the book offers a key read for academics and students of international history and international relations and others studying japan or east asia in the twentieth century

beyond citizenship focuses on the role of literacy in building a modern nation state by examining the government provision of adult literacy training in early twentieth century china based on untapped archives and

diaries di Luo uncovers people's strategic use of literacy and illiteracy in social interactions and explores the impact of daily experiences on the expansion of state power highlighting interpersonal and intergroup relations beyond citizenship suggests a new methodology of studying literacy which foregrounds the agentive role of historical actors and so moves away from a more traditional approach that treats literacy itself as the key factor enabling social change

news under fire china's propaganda against japan in the english language press 1928 1941 is the first comprehensive study of china's efforts to establish an effective international propaganda system during the sino-japanese crisis it explores how the weak nationalist government managed to use its limited resources to compete with japan in the international press by retrieving the long neglected history of english language papers published in the treaty ports shuge wei reveals a multilayered and often chaotic english language media environment in china and demonstrates its vital importance in defending china's sovereignty chinese bilingual elites played an important role in linking the party-led propaganda system with the treaty port press yet the development of propaganda institution did not foster the realization of individual ideals as the sino-japanese crisis deepened the war machine absorbed treaty port journalists into the militarized propaganda system and dashed their hopes of maintaining a liberal information order a superbly researched and well nuanced account of an overlooked topic nationalist china's propaganda system and the multiple ways in which it intersected with the treaty port foreign language press of the time combining a wealth of archival and newspaper sources it is destined to be on the must read list of all who are interested in state propaganda and news dissemination in the republican period julia c. strauss professor of chinese politics soas university of london an absorbing and well sourced study of kmt propaganda efforts to convince the united states to side with china rather than japan in wwii the study shows how the kmt facing a massive power asymmetry compared to its japanese opponent managed to effectively use the soft power of foreign propaganda rudolf g. wagner senior professor of chinese studies cluster of excellence asia and europe heidelberg university germany

utilizes archival documents to argue against the perception that america turned its back on china during the paris peace conference a belief that convinced many chinese to turn to soviet russia instead the author contends that president wilson did everything in his power to help china chapters focus on topics such as the origins of the united front policy assertion of soviet control over the chinese eastern railway the restoration of

during the soviet period the ussr conducted diplomatic relations with incumbent regimes while simultaneously cultivating and manipulating communist movements in those same countries the chinese case offers a particularly interesting example of this dual policy for when the chinese communists came to power in 1949 their discovery of the nature of moscow s imperial designs on chinese territory sowed distrust between the two revolutionary powers and paved the way to the sino soviet split drawing on newly available documents from archives in china taiwan russia and japan this study examines secret agreements signed by moscow and the peking government in 1924 and confirmed by a soviet japanese convention in 1925 these agreements essentially allowed the bolsheviks to reclaim most of tsarist russia s concessions and privileges in china including not only imperial properties but also outer mongolia the chinese eastern railway the boxer indemnity and the right of extraterritoriality each of these topics is analyzed in this volume and translations of the secret protocols themselves are included in a documentary appendix additional chapters discuss sino soviet diplomacy and the parallel history of soviet relations with the chinese communist party as well as the origins and purpose of the united front policy

revised and updated this thoughtful balanced and highly readable work provides a succinct yet comprehensive and cohesive overview of china s path to modernization preparing readers to understand the complex interaction between the chinese cultural traditional and the internal and external pressures for change that led china onto the path of revolution and communism evaluating the impact of mao ze dong s thought and action on china s development it explores the nature of deng xiao ping s second revolution that reversed many of maoist policies that put the country on the road to economic prosperity but which also created serious economic and political imbalances that will continue to plague china in the near future develops and sustains a narrative line not usually available in survey histories of china presenting an internal coherence within each chapter that provides not only an integrated picture of political cultural and economic developments but also a convenient foundation to grasp the sequence of fundamental changes in china provides a brief summary of china s past history focusing on the ideology and institutions that molded chinese political culture covers critical transition periods such as the collapse of the manchu dynasty and the establishment of the first republic the shift of

power from the nationalists to the communists and the rise of deng xiao ping after the passing away of mao ze dong expands coverage on many areas including tibet prc in taiwan and hong kong the sino indian war of 1962 and the sino vietnamese war of 1979 plus social economic and cultural topics in various periods

this dictionary covers the period 1789 1945 a revised edition it includes new entries and the text has been brought up to date to reflect information current at the time of publication it includes the non european world social economic and ideological developments and political events
